STUDENTS IN ARMY OR NAVY: During this year there were 578 men in the armed services included in the enrollment: Army 64 (all in the medical school); 514 Navy (96 in the medical school, 412 in engineering, and 6 were physics majors). However, before the end of the year, 2 Army and 215 Navy men withdrew, 62 Army and 143 Navy men were discharged, leaving 156 Navy V-12 and N-ROTC men still enrolled— all in engineering.
