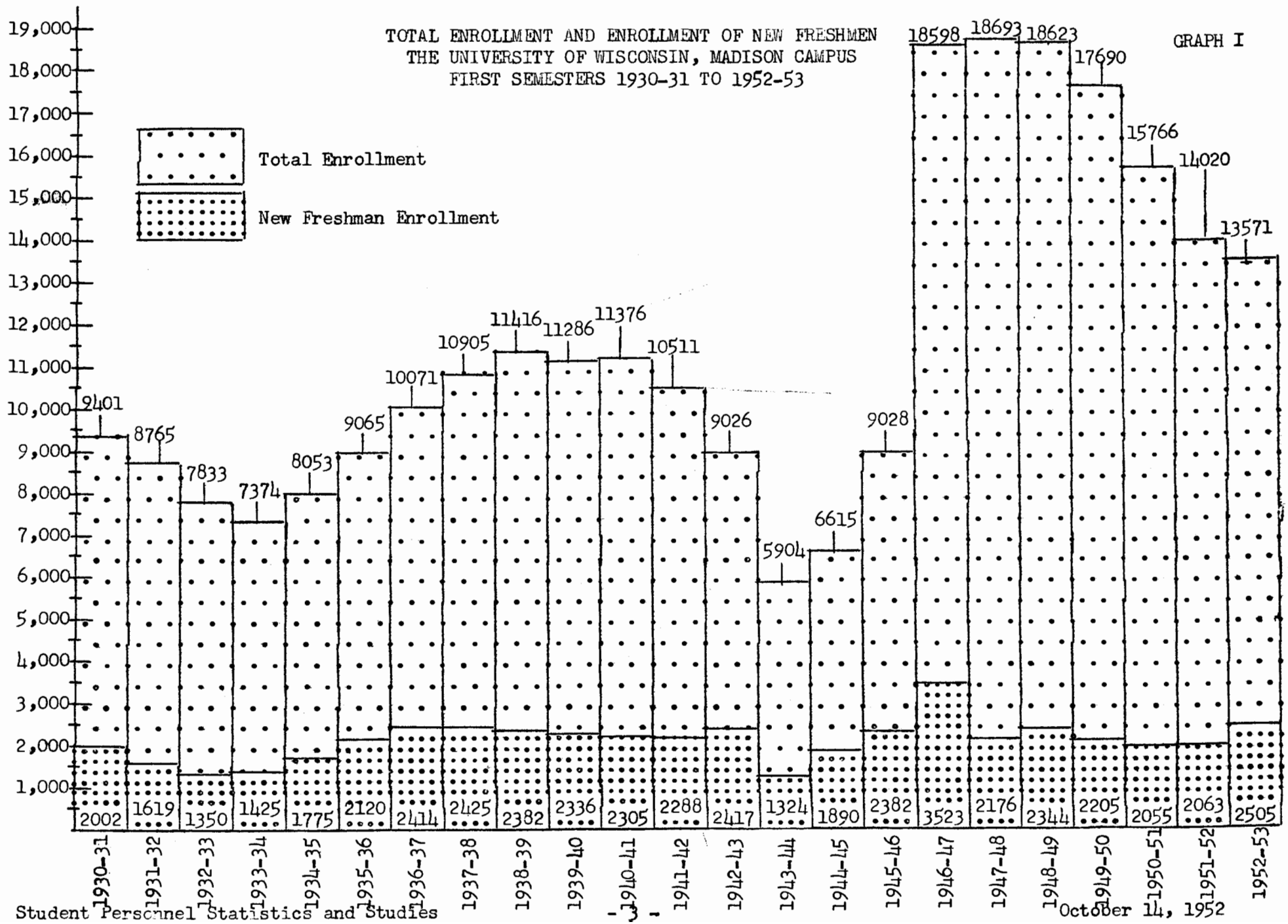

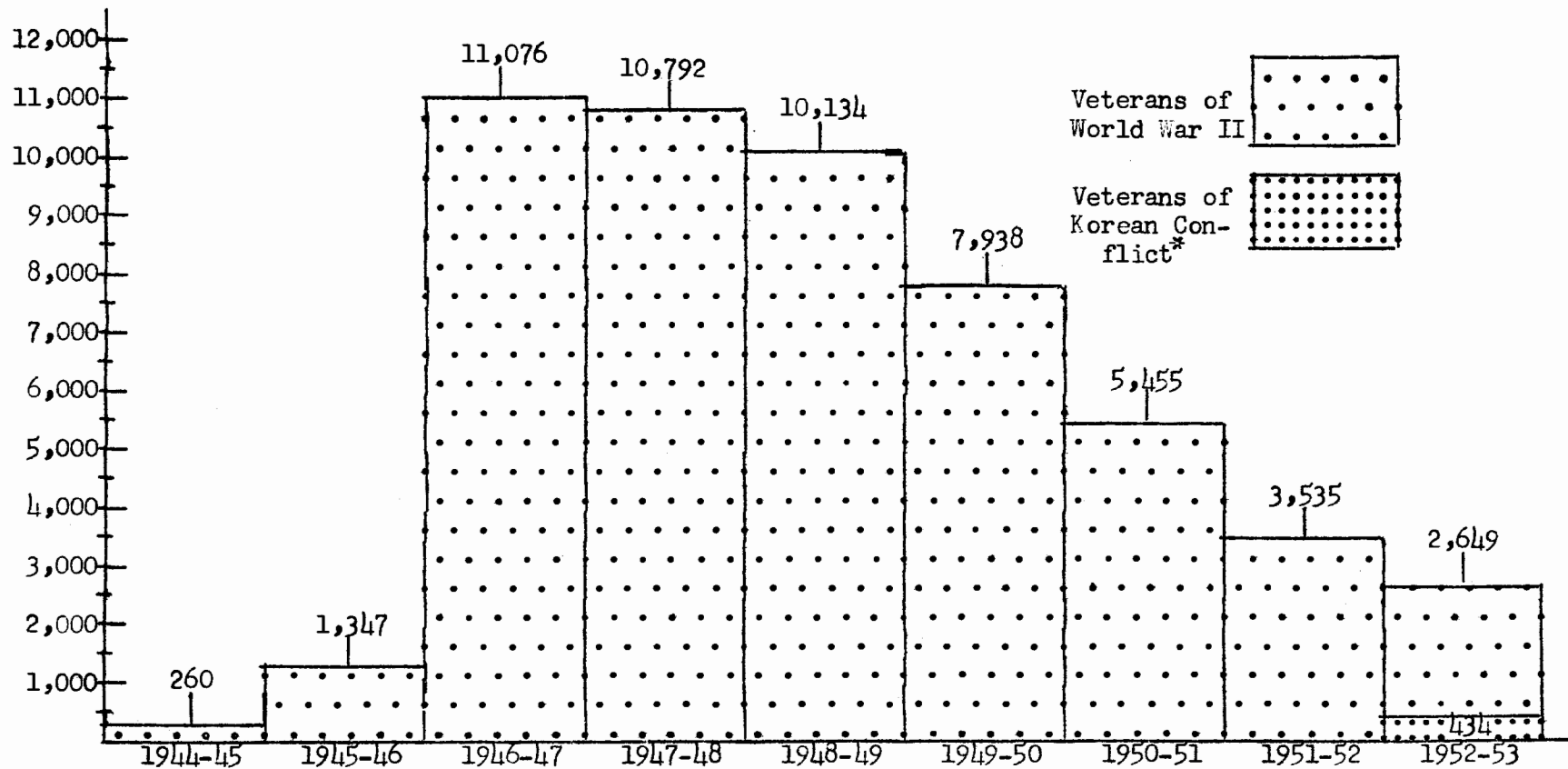
TOTAL ENROLLMENT AND ENROLLMENT OF NEW FRESHMEN
