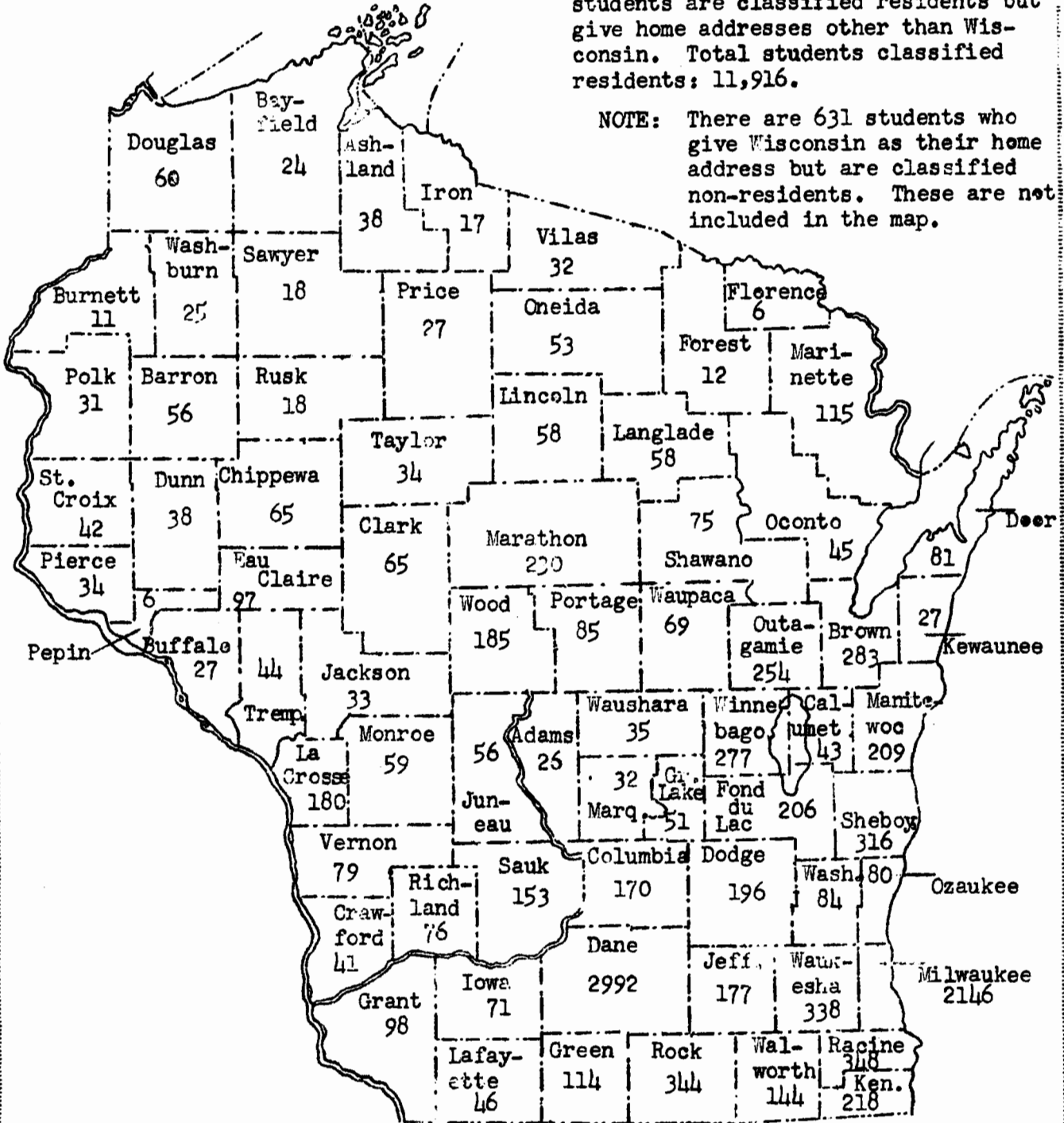
DISTRIBUTION OF HOME ADDRESSES OF WISCONSIN RESIDENT* STUDENTS

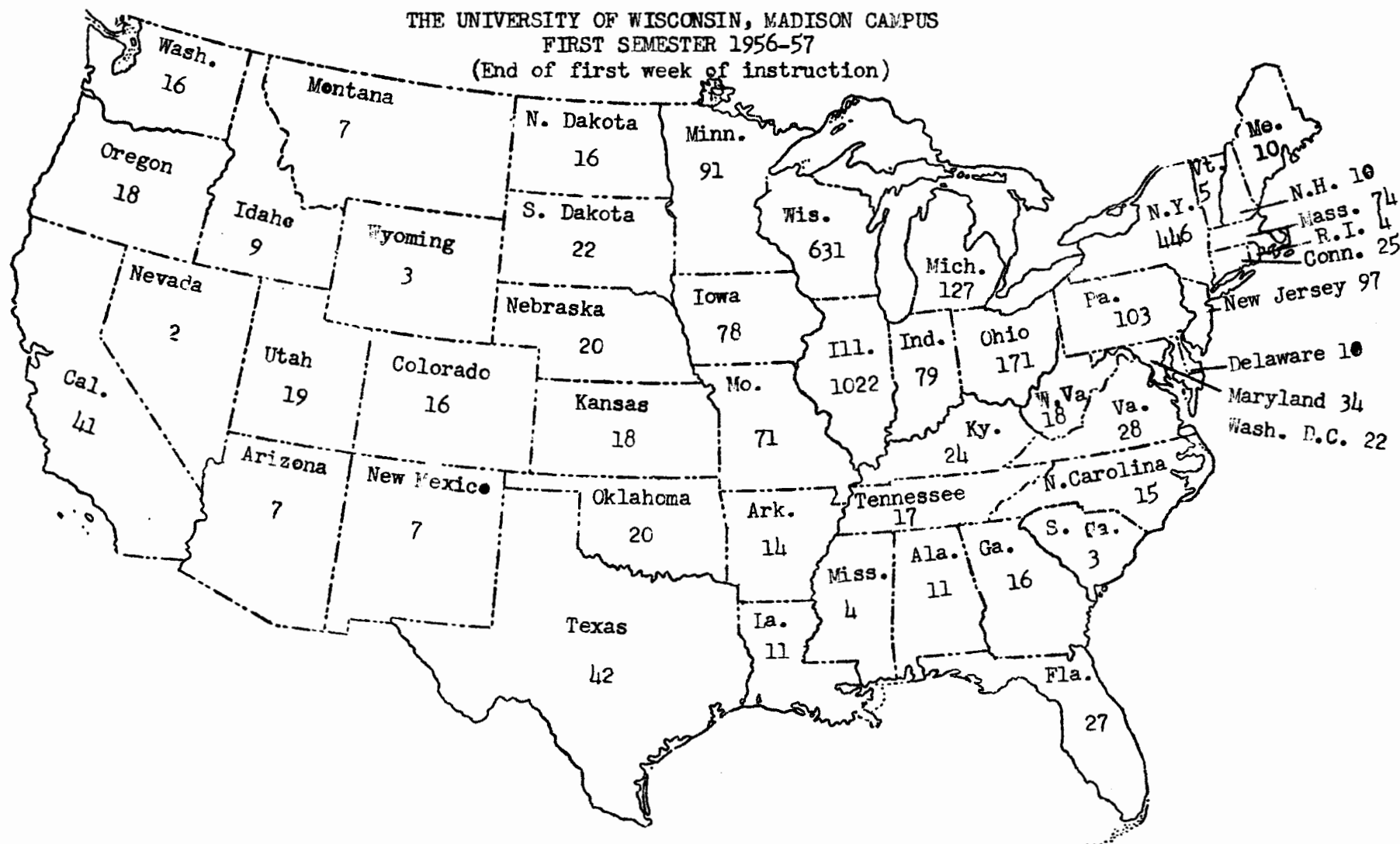


DISTRIBUTION OF HOME ADDRESSES OF NON-RESIDENT* STUDENTS BY STATES
