I am enclosing a copy of the complete enrollment report of day students for the second semester 1958-59. The report includes students registered on the Madison campus through the end of the first week of instruction. Also included is a supplementary report which includes students registered through the eighth week of instruction.

Page one of the report gives the day enrollment at the eight extension centers and at the Milwaukee division. On page ten you will also find a break-down of Milwaukee graduates by sex, college, and current entrance status.


Total enrollment increases this semester over a year ago are as follows: Madison, 4.7 per cent; Milwaukee, 8.2 per cent; extension centers, 13.4 per cent; and total of all campuses, 6.0 per cent.

On the Madison campus, over a year ago, there is an increase of 3.5 per cent in men; 7.6 per cent in women; 7.3 per cent in married students; 5.3 per cent in continuing and re-entering students; and a decrease of 16.3 in new freshmen; 10.5 in new advanced standing; and 25.9 per cent in veterans receiving benefits under public laws 550 and 894.

The eight-week supplementary report shows that 67 students have registered since the first week of instruction making the total registration 16,360 on the Madison campus; of the additional registrants 63 are in the Graduate School.

At the end of the eighth week of classes, 321 students had withdrawn leaving a registration at the end of the eighth week of classes of 16,039. Fifty-six per cent of the withdrawals were freshmen or sophomores.
