## ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

The 1967-68 fall report shows a total enrollment of 33,000 students, an increase of 6.0% over the fall semester a year ago. Last year's increase was 6.2% over the prior fall. There is a 4.5% increase in undergraduates, a 10.2% increase in graduate students, and a 6.0% increase in professional students. The corresponding changes last year were: Undergraduates up 4.8%, graduates up 11.2%, and a 0.7% decline in professionals. We note that enrollment has more than doubled in the last ten years (15,929 in 1957-58). Undergraduates are up 88.1%, graduates are up 203.1%, and professionals are up 35.8%.

For the second year in a row there is a decline in new freshmen; 4,304 compared to 4,719 the previous year, a drop of 8.8%. The new freshmen figure in the fall of 1965 was 5,206; the drop last year was 9.1%. The resident new freshmen were up 5.9%, the non-resident showed a decline of 32.2%. This decline in non-residents reflects the policy of gradually limiting total non-resident undergraduates to 25% of the undergraduate student body. Based on the Coordinating Committee for Higher Education's definition of non-residents (i.e. using permanent home address rather than fee assessments) Table XII shows that 27% of this fall's undergraduates are non-residents compared to 29% last fall.

The percent change in new freshmen by college this year and in each of the previous five years is as follows:

Resident students are 60.1% of the total compared to 59.5% last year; 70.4% of the undergraduates, 32.4% of the graduates, and 75.7% of the professionals are residents. Of the new freshmen 71.3% are residents; in the fall of 1966-67 only 61.3% of the new freshmen were residents.

There was a substantial increase (25.2%) in advance standing students this fall compared to an 8.7% increase last fall. The next highest increase since 1957-58 was 13.6 in the fall of 1965.

There are 1,644 foreign students from 95 different countries. Foreign students are 1.6% of the undergraduates, 13.9% of the graduates, and 0.8% of the professional students. Thirty-eight of these foreign countries had ten or more students on campus.

For the first time since 1956-57 the percent of enrollment of women to total students has dropped; 38.7% in 1966-67 and 38.3% this year.

Married students are 20.7% of the total student body; 8.5% of the undergraduates are married, 49.5% of the graduates, and 38.2% of the professionals.

Included in our report this year are 39 students (Extension Specials) who are students enrolled in the Migrant Youth on Campus program, which is part of the National High School Equivalency program. These students are not enrolled in University level courses during the first semester. They are under the direction of the Extension division.

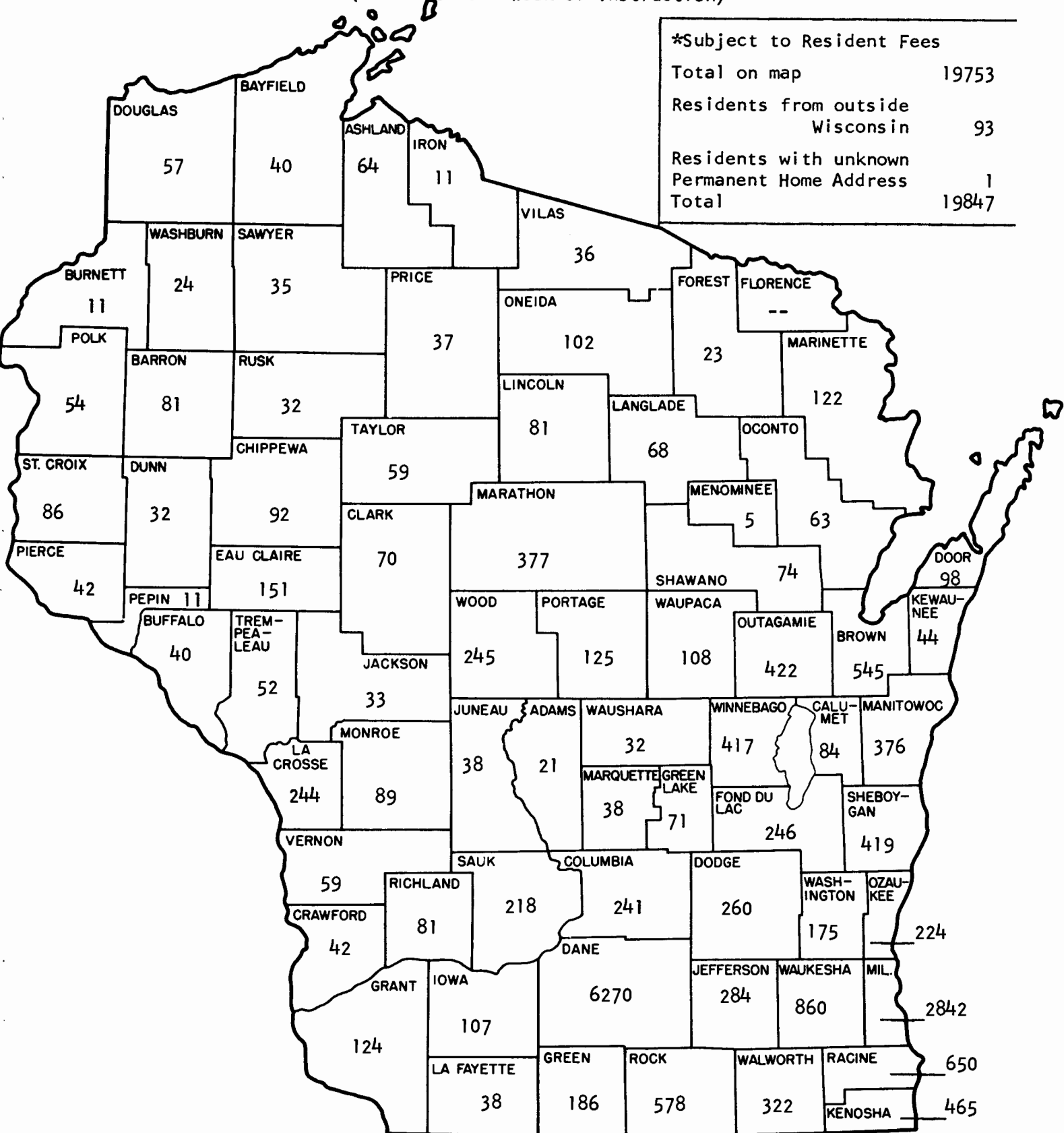

DISTRIBUTION OF HOME ADDRESSES OF WISCONSIN RESIDENT\* STUDENTS

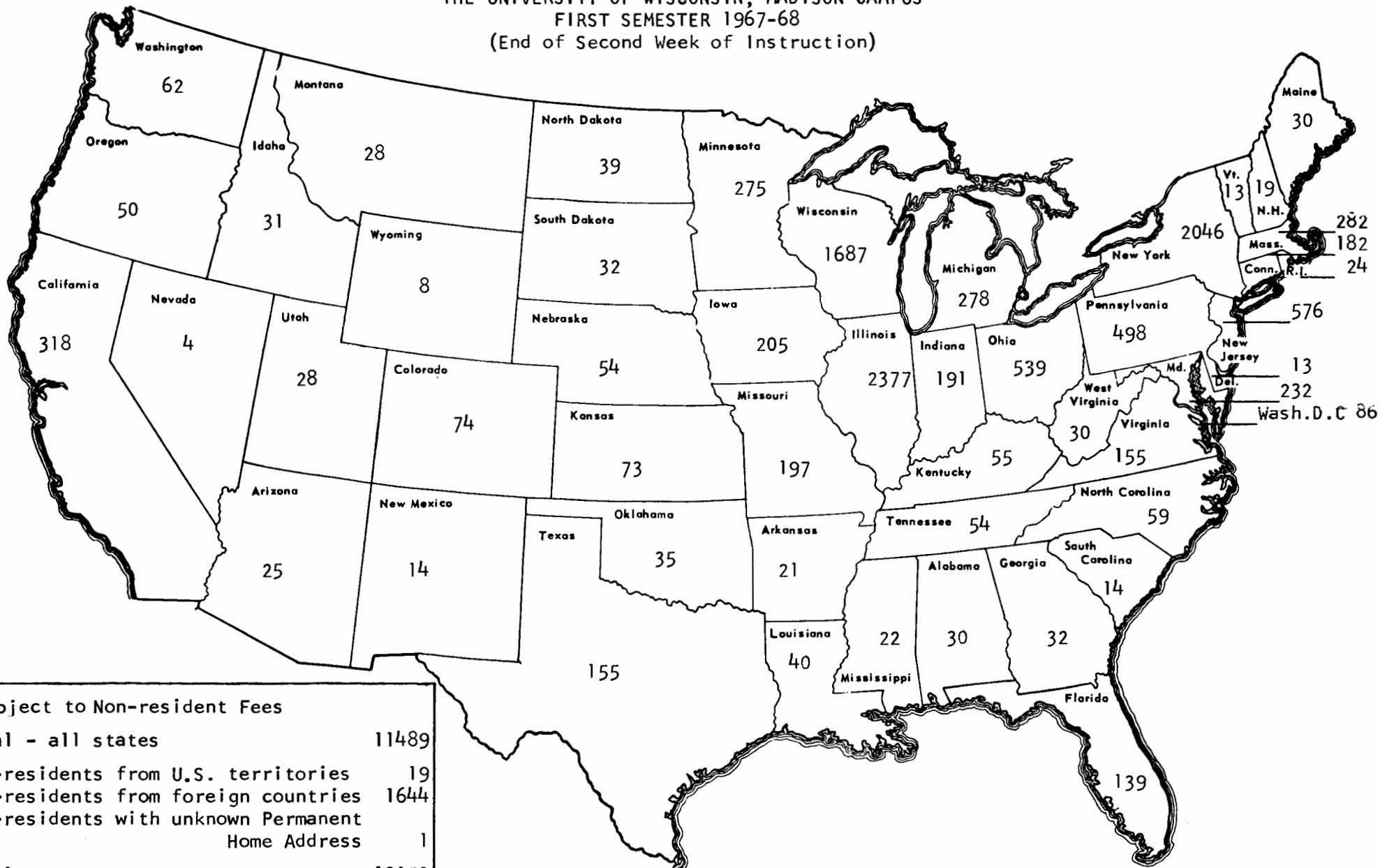
