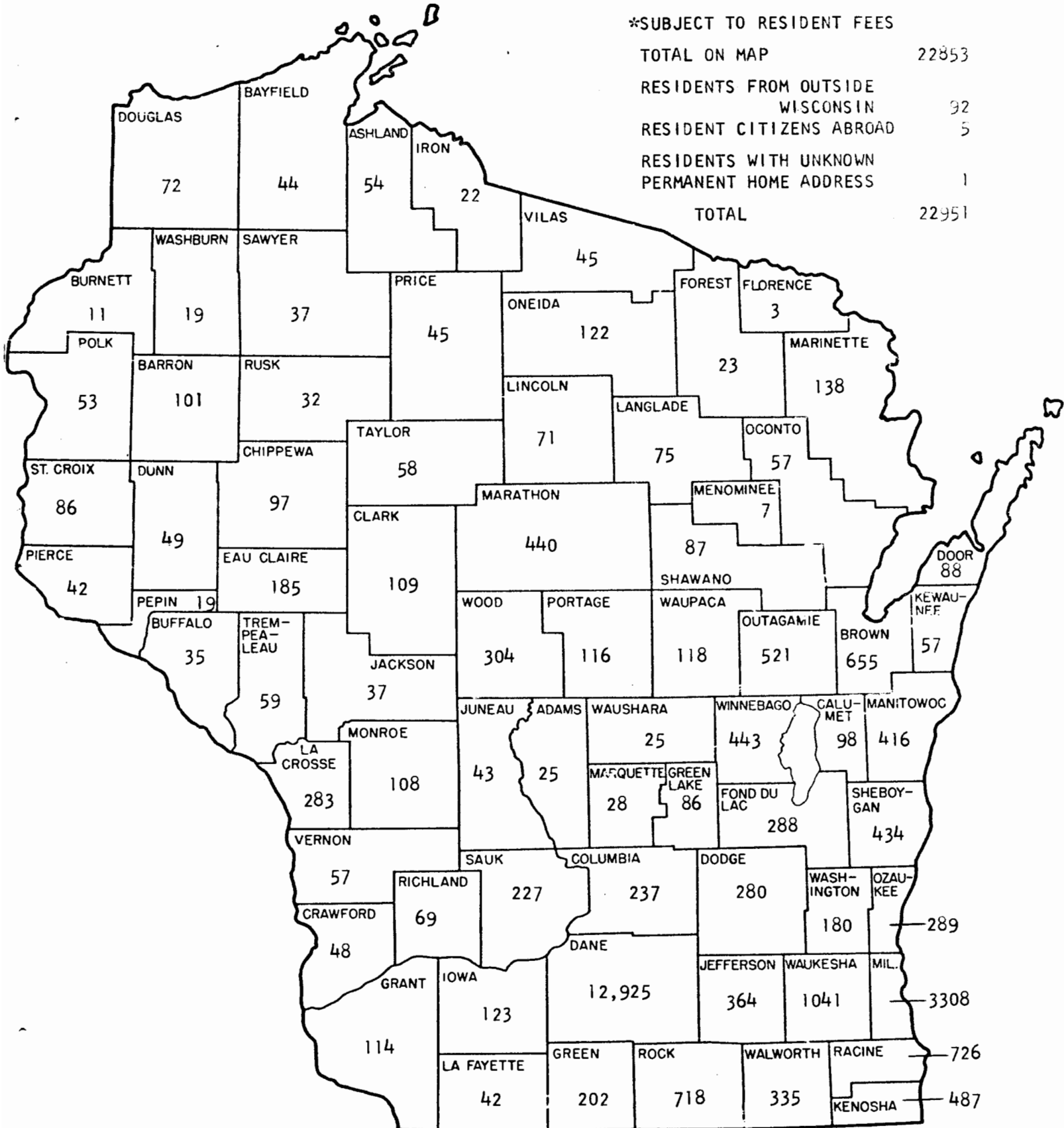

DISTRIBUTION OF HOME ADDRESSES OF WISCONSIN RESIDENT* STUDENTS

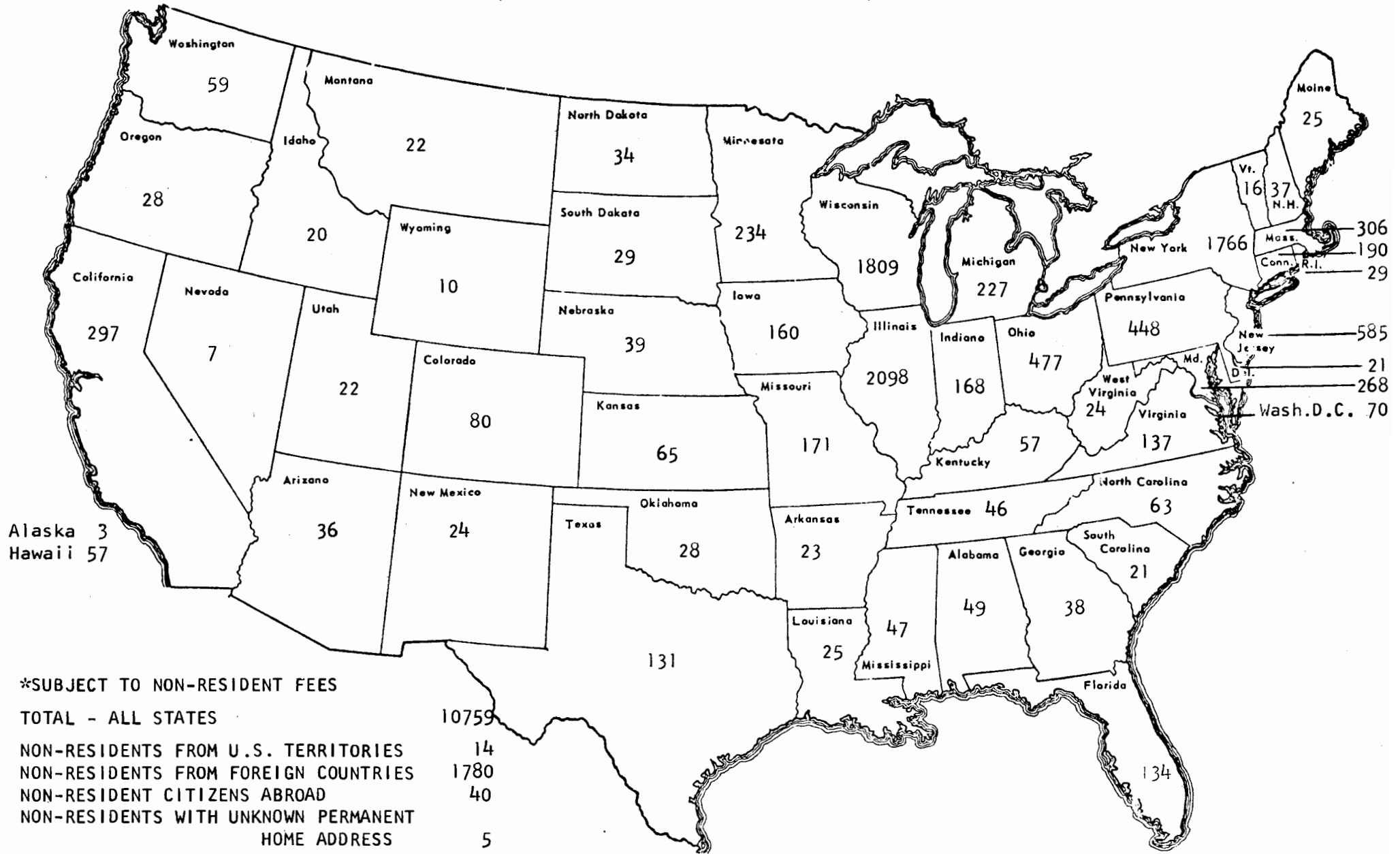
