We note that the 'Distribution of Students by Age' Table for the First Semester 1974-75 Enrollment Report was as of January 31, 1974 instead of August 31, 1974 as reported. Therefore, caution should be used in comparing these figures with other years.

Note also that the median figures on Table XIV B should not be used for either the First or Second Semester of 1974-75. On Table XII for the Second Semester of 1974-75 the correct mean and median figures for the column headed Specials (SPLS) should be 6.1 and 3.9 respectively instead of 10.5 and 11.6 as presently reported.
