Dear Colleague:

Under the familiar cover of the University of Wisconsin - Madison Enrollment Report this fall you will find a new style of enrollment reporting for this University. The computer programs which provide enrollment information have been rewritten to take advantage of the latest developments in programming, printing, and telecommunications. Most of the tables remain the same for easy comparison with previous reports, but a few changes should be noted.

The Student Classification By College table has been expanded to include all of the student classifications and specifies joint registrants between colleges. The previous table had summarized classifications and joint registrants were listed in a separate table.

The Majors table now includes majors for freshmen and sophomores and takes into account multiple majors for an individual student. Previous major tables tallied only the first major for a student. The new tables show a Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) value for each major. Students who haven't indicated a major are tallied at the conclusion of the table.

Three current entrance tables are provided with breakdowns for Men/Women, Resident/Non-Resident, and Full Time/Part Time. Transfers from University of Wisconsin-System Schools are included, as before, and a new table displaying the Wisconsin High Schools of New Freshmen has been added. High School Percentile Ranks of New Freshmen are also displayed.

Tallies of the Permanent Home Addresses of our students have always been a part of the enrollment report. The new report distinguishes between foreign and non-foreign students in these tallies. Foreign students are listed by their country of citizenship and this provides an accurate tally of the number of foreign students at Madison. Individuals with Permanent Resident or Refugee Status are tallied along with all other United States Citizens in the Permanent Home Address and Resident Fee Assessment Status For Non-Foreign table.

The enrollment report also contains two maps which tally our students by permanent home address, a tabulation of all degrees granted by the University of Wisconsin - Madison in Fiscal Year 1982-83, and the enrollment and credits in the Farm and Industry Short Course Program.

We appreciate your interest in this enrollment report and welcome your comments.

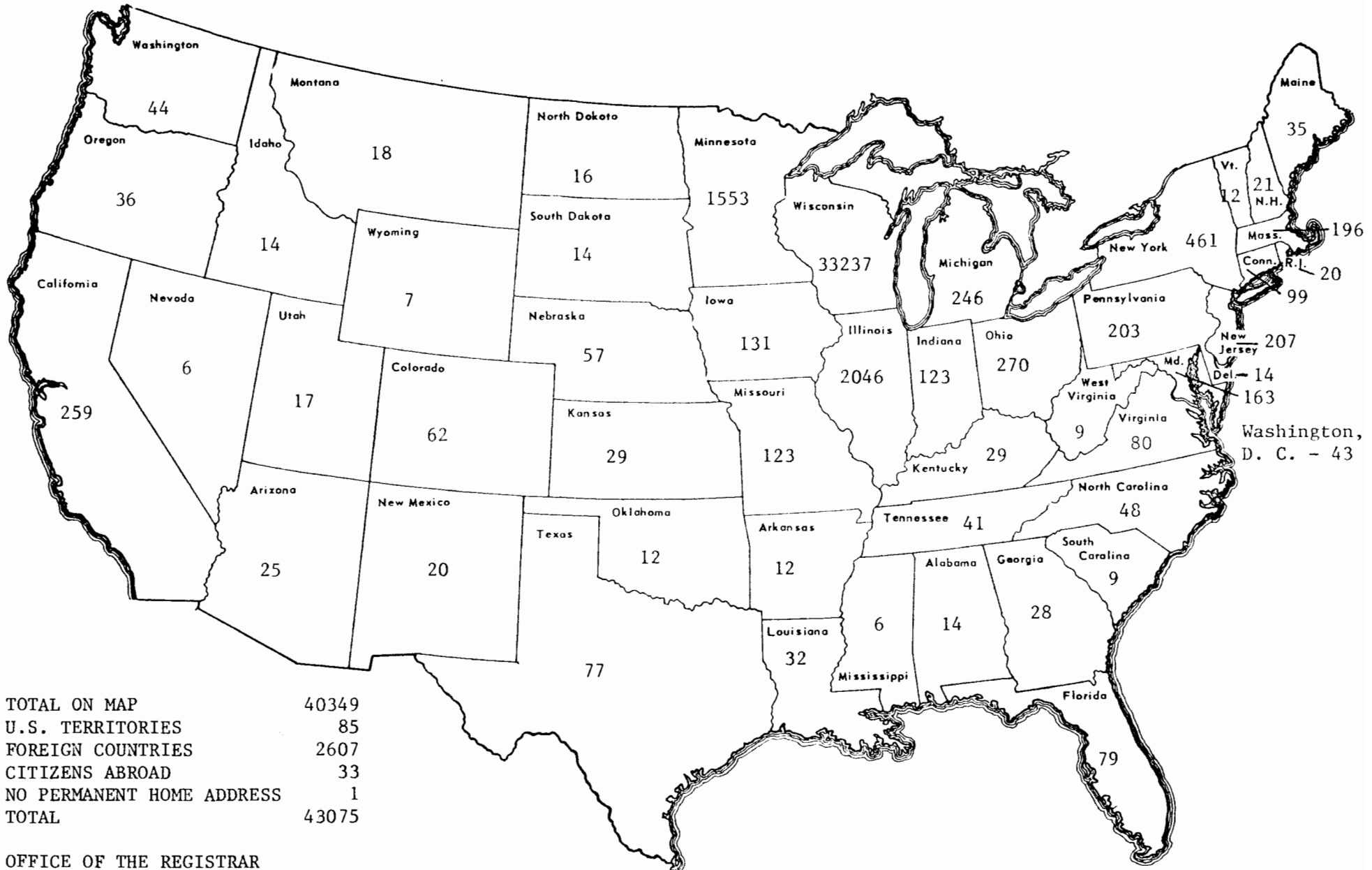
