*SE Asian: A student who is a US Citizen, permanent resident or refugee of Laotian, Cambodian, or Vietnamese heritage and came to the US prior to the end of the Vietnam war or is descended from such a person. Used to identify Southeast Asian students for campus diversity initiatives.

**Minority status is a computed field combining a student's ethnic group and citizen status. The resulting codes help identify students who may be eligible for Federal, State or campus diversity initiatives and programs. US Citizens, permanent residents, and refugees (Citizen_Status = 1, 2, 3, 6 or 7) are grouped by their ethnic group. International students (Citizen_Status = 4 or 5), regardless of ethnic group, are put in their own category (International).

Valid values are:

- 1 = White
- 2 = Black
- 3 = Hispanic
- 4 = Asian/Pacific Islander
- 5 = American Indian/Alaskan Native
- U = Unknown
- F = International student

***Non-Citizen is determined exclusively by citizenship status and should not be confused with International. There are seven categories under citizenship:

- 1 = Native
- 2 = Naturalized
- 3 = Alien Permanent
- 4 = Alien Temporary
- 5 = Alien
- 6 = Refugee
- 7 = Domestic, Status Pending

For purposes of this report values 1 and 2 are reported as Citizen, 3,4,5, 6 and 7 are reported as Non-Citizen.

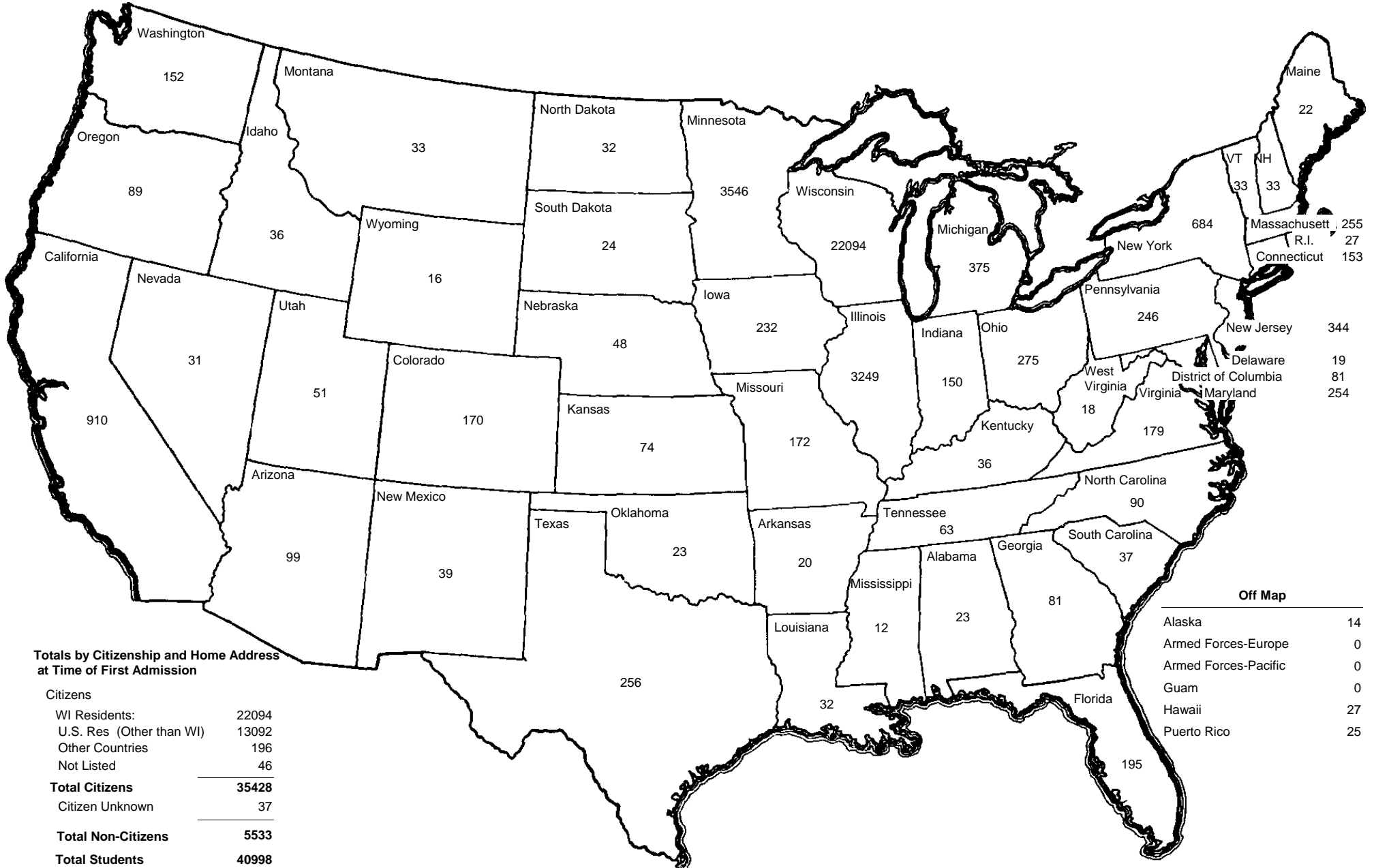
